The mission of KCSU is to teach students to collaboratively operate a radio station that offers audio & multi-media education by providing hands-on learning experiences that amplify student voices to create content informing and inspiring our listeners.

KCSU News Mission Statement: To provide CSU students and residents of Fort Collins informative and enjoyable news coverage, local and beyond. KCSU News strives to uphold the value of objectivity and journalistic ethics to the utmost degree.

News Department Overview: The KCSU News Department is responsible for keeping our listening audience informed/educated by reporting the news through an unbiased local lens. Coverage includes campus stories, community reporting, and global news. Additional responsibilities involve editing pre-recorded segments and collaborating/managing KCSU's freelance reporters and volunteers.

Supervision Given and Received: The KCSU News Department is overseen by the KCSU Program Director with support from the KCSU Station Manager.

- The News Director is ultimately responsible for the entire News Department.
 - Specific News Department tasks are delegated by the News Director to the Assistant News Director.
 - o Assistants can delegate tasks to volunteers and manage their performance with the consent of their director.
 - o The Producer is responsible for the broadcast of the news program, *Rocky Mountain Review*. The producer must either run the board for the live show or create a pre-recorded audio file for the broadcast utilizing audio files provided by the News Director(s).

Preferred Knowledge/Skills/Abilities:

- Understanding of AP style writing/reporting
- Basic knowledge of high production standards and production equipment
- Knowledge of digital publication, which includes podcast creation/distribution.
- Willingness to learn or understand audio broadcasts and FCC requirements/restrictions

- 4. (Optional) News report, pre-recorded segment, or interview

Instructions: Email a PDF of your completed application packet to station@kcsufm.com by midnight April 18th. In your email, please include all the times you are available for a 1 hour interview between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. from April 21st to April 25th.

All News Department positions are available. In your cover letter, please specify which position you are applying for (you may ONLY be hired for one). You will partake in one interview for director, assistant, lor producer.

All paid KCSU staff are expected to apply for non-need work study in early April and use this for their position at KCSU (unless need based work study has been awarded). Work Study Disclaimers:

- Hourly Pay Rate: All KCSU positions pay \$15 an hour, with hours varying between departments/positions. It is anticipated hours for this position will fluctuate, especially during active KCSU technical issues/emergencies.
 - o The News Director works 12 hours a week for the 2025-26 academic year
 - o The Assistant News Director works 6 hours a week for the 2025-26 academic year
 - o The News Producer works 2 hours a week for the 2025-26 academic year
 - All KCSU staff positions must either be a CSU, Front Range, or local high school/college student enrolled for at least one credit hour.

- Start Date: August 18, 2025. Training dates will be communicated after an applicant has been selected for this role.
