## Charges for Technology Report for Fiscal Year 2025

The table below contains the schedule of the per-semester Charges for Technology in place during the current fiscal year, FY25, and charges for FY26.

In a unanimous vote, CAS CFT would like to increase their tech fee charges by \$4.50 (5%) to \$94.50. They have taken on a new 65 seat Computer Lab in the Nutrien building that will require refreshing at an estimated \$130,000 every 4-5 years. In addition, their newly purchased Laptop Kiosk will be refreshed on a 5 year cycle as well, which is an estimated \$150,000- 180,000 expense. They are also requesting the increase due to price increases in the industry, especially around software licensing. Lastly, they have adjusted the hourly salaries of their Student IT Technician staff to better reflect pay for similar work around campus, which CFT Funds pay for. These additional items that the CFT Committee have taken on recently are estimated to be \$310,000 - \$350,000 every 5 years, or roughly \$62,000 - \$70,000 per year. Their current carry over, and planned expenses will not be sufficient in the coming years.

With last year's increase, and this new increase, they should be good to field proposals for new technologies in the near future.

The College of Health and Human Sciences voted to increase fees by \$3.91 to \$82.13. Increasing the technology fee is necessary to keep up with increasing costs, including the cost of hardware, software and personnel. College received approval from student leadership in February 2025.

Intra-University proposed a \$2 increase to accommodate cost of living wages increase for student staff, taking on percentage of CSUMYMAJORS.com subscription with Admissions, increasing costs of Microsoft Licensing and server maintenance.

The College of Liberal Arts is raising the technology fee by 5% to account for increases in cost of technology, student employment, and implementing higher level of technology in critical spaces. The increase is being made with the support of their student technology fee committee.

Warner College of Natural Resources has not increased the student CFT rate since FY09 and is requesting a 5% increase for FY26. The cost of hardware and software required to deliver student technology services has increased annually and the college is now facing a significant level of deferred maintenance. In order to continue offering core services, the student CFT rate will need to be increased.
